Nationwide Crime Analysis Mid-Year January to June 2021 vs 2020

Preliminary figures for Mid-Year 2021, indicate that major crimes decreased by 8% with 1,916 cases, compared to 2,087 over the same period in 2020. There were regional decreases in New Providence, Grand Bahama District and the Family Islands District at rates of 8%, 3% and 13%, respectively, compared to 2020.

Crimes against the person increased by 32%, with 425 incidents, compared to 322 in 2020. There was a 10% increase in New Providence, 4% increase in Grand Bahama and 43% decrease in the Family Islands. Property crimes decreased by 16%, with 1,491 incidents, compared to 1,765 in 2020. There were regional decreases across the board including a 17% decrease in New Providence, 5% decrease in Grand Bahama and a 16% decrease in the Family Islands.

Homicides increased by 62% with 60 incidents, compared to 37 over the same period in 2020. There were 55 murders in New Providence, 4 in Grand Bahama District and 1 in the Family Islands District, with an overall solvency rate of 55%. Victims between the ages of 18 and 35 represented 48% of all homicides. Homicides were more prevalent in the **Northeastern Division**, accounting for 22% of the overall total. Based on preliminary figures, homicides were more likely to occur on a Monday or Thursday than any other day of the week. Firearms were used in the commission of 51 homicides and fatal gunshot wounds remain the leading cause of death for homicides.

Armed robberies increased by 41% with 199 incidents, compared to 141 over the same period in 2020. Armed robberies were more prevalent in the **South-Central Division**, accounting for 24% of the overall total. Based on preliminary figures, armed robberies were more likely to occur on a Thursday than any other day of the week and these incidents peak at night between the hours of 7pm and 10pm. Most armed robberies occurred at business establishments, at the street level and at residences respectively. Firearms continue to be the weapon of choice for the commission of armed robberies. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 60%, compared to female victims at 40%.

Robberies increased by 17% with 49 incidents, compared to 42 over the same period in 2020. Robberies were more prevalent in the **Central** and **Southwestern Divisions**, which accounted for a collective 33% of the overall total. Based on preliminary figures, robberies were more likely to occur on a Wednesday than any other day of the week and these incidents peak between the hours of 1pm and 8pm. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 70%, compared to female victims at 30%.

Stolen vehicles increased by 32% with 150 incidents, compared to 114 over the same period in 2020. **Nissans** and **Hondas** were the most targeted vehicles of choice, representing 48% and 42% respectively of all vehicles stolen. Most vehicles were stolen from the owner's residence. Stolen vehicles were mostly reported in the **Southwestern Division**, accounting for 25% of the overall total. Twenty-seven percent of stolen vehicles were recovered.

Stealing from vehicles decreased by 45% with 310 incidents, compared to 561 over the same period in 2020. The most frequent items stolen included tools, cash, and personal effects. Nissan Notes were mostly targeted, with Honda Accords and Fits trending close behind. Based on preliminary figures, stealing from vehicles were more likely to occur on a Monday than any other day of the week. Stealing

from vehicles were mostly reported in the **Southwestern Division**, accounting for 16% of recorded matters.

Housebreakings decreased by 3% with 279 incidents, compared to 289 over the same period in 2020. **New Providence District** accounted for 176 or 63% of housebreakings, most of which occurred in the **Eastern Division** accounting for 13% of all cases. **Grand Bahama**, including **Abaco and Bimini**, accounted for 61 or 22% of housebreakings. The **Family Islands District** accounted for the remaining 42 or 15%, most of which occurred in Eleuthera with 15 incidents. Based on preliminary figures, housebreakings were more likely to occur on a Tuesday than any other day of the week.

Shopbreakings decreased by 32% with 199 incidents, compared to 291 over the same period in 2020. **New Providence District** accounted for 146 or 73% of shopbreakings, most of which occurred in the **Northeastern Division** with 33 incidents. **Grand Bahama**, including **Abaco and Bimini**, accounted for 19 or 10% of shopbreakings, most of which occurred in the **Southwestern Division** with 6 incidents. The **Family Islands District** accounted for the remaining 34 or 17%, most of which occurred in **Eleuthera** with 14 incidents. Based on preliminary figures, shopbreakings were more likely to occur on a Friday than any other day of the week.

For the period in review, a total of 152 **firearms** and 2,296 rounds of ammunition were discovered and seized throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result, 126 persons were charged with possession of illegal firearms. Additionally, **ShotSpotter** detected 317 gunshot incidents, consisting of 215 multiple shots, 71 single shots and 31 probable shots, totaling 1,410 rounds discharged.


There were 2,540 breaches to the Emergency Powers Order, including 741 curfew violations and 786 other breaches. The Force also responded to 29 Covid 19 calls for assistance. Furthermore, officers of the Royal Bahamas Police Force conducted 12,896 field check patrols, 472 road checks and executed 436 warrants of arrest throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result of these efforts, 9,353 persons were arrested, and 4,493 suspects were charged before the Court. This figure represents an overall 48% detection rate for major and minor crimes. There were 1,484 convictions in the Magistrates Court and 13 acquittals. Three hundred, twenty-two matters were discharged and 147 matters were withdrawn by the virtual complainant.



For the period in review, murders increased by 62% with 60 cases compared to 37 over the same period in 2020.











Murder Solvency Rate Mid-Year 2021



Sexual Offences






For the period in review, armed robberies increased by 41% with 199 incidents, compared to 141 in 2020.


Armed Robbery - Mid-Year 2021 vs 2020


















Housebreakings










Stealing from Vehicle

For the period in review, stealing from a vehicle decreased by 45% with 310 incidents, compared to 561 over the same period in 2020. Items of choice stolen from vehicles mostly consisted of tools, documents and cash. Residences were the most targeted areas for this crime representing 55% of stealing incidents. Stealing from vehicles mostly occurred with the South Western Division.






Stealing from Vehicle - Items Stolen Mid-Year 2021




Stealing from Vehicle - Location Type Mid-Year 2021





Stolen Vehicle






Detection Rates - All Bahamas Mid-Year 2021






Cybercrime

Persons Arrested

For the period in review, the police arrested 9,353 persons for various major and minor offences throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. **New Providence** accounted for 7,503 or 80% of all persons arrested, **Grand Bahama & the Northern Bahamas** accounted for 1,359 or 15%, and the **Family Islands District** accounted for 491 or 5%. Males accounted for 7,994 or 85% of arrests, and females accounted for the remaining 1359 or 15% of arrests.









Persons Charged

For the period in review, the police charged 4,493 persons for various major and minor offences throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. **New Providence** accounted for 3,290 or 73% of all persons arrested, **Grand Bahama & the Northern Bahamas** accounted for 714 or 16%, and the **Family Islands District** accounted for 489 or 11%. Males accounted for 3,695 or 82% of persons charged, and females accounted for the remaining 798 or 18% of persons charged.

Persons Charged ■ New Providence ■GB & Northern Family Islands







Court Case Disposition

Case Disposition




Convictions




Productivity Loss

For the period in review, the Organization accounted for 28,452 sick days at an estimated loss of \$3.596m. Police Officers on industrial leave accounted for 5,810 or 20% of the overall sick days. The contracted ranks accounted for \$3.225m or 90% of all productivity losses due to sick reports. The New Providence District accounted for \$2.949m or 82% of the overall productivity losses with Grand Bahama District and the Family Islands District accounting for 10% and 8% respectively.
