Nationwide Crime Analysis 2021 vs 2020

Preliminary figures for 2021 indicate that major crimes remain unchanged with 4,081 cases, compared to 4,064 in 2020. There was a 13% regional decrease in crime on the Family Islands when compared to 2020. There were regional increases in New Providence and Grand Bahama at rates of 2% and 1% respectively, when compared to 2020.

Notably, there were regional decreases in crimes against the property across the board for 2021 at rates of 3% in New Providence, 1% in Grand Bahama and 9% on the Family Islands. Crimes against the person increased by 18% with 870 incidents, compared to 736 in 2020. There was a 38% regional decrease in crimes against the person on the Family Islands when compared to 2020. However, there were regional increases in New Providence and Grand Bahama at rates of 22% and 19% respectively.

Homicides increased by 63% with 119 incidents, compared to 73 in 2020. There were 104 murders in New Providence, 12 in Grand Bahama, and 3 in the Family Islands District, with an overall solvency rate of 56%. Victims between the ages of 18 and 35 represented 64% of all homicides. Retaliation and conflict were the most common motives for murder representing 45% collectively. Based on preliminary figures, homicides were more likely to occur on a Thursday than any other day of the week. Homicides were more prevalent in the **Northeastern, Southern and South Central Divisions,** accounting for 45% of the overall total. Fatal gunshot wound was the leading cause of death for homicides accounting for 104 incidents.

Armed Robberies increased by 33% with 415 incidents, compared to 313 in 2020. Armed robberies occurred mostly between the hours of 6pm and 10pm. Based on preliminary figures armed robberies were more likely to occur on a Thursday than any other day of the week. Armed Robberies were more prevalent in the **Southwestern, Northeastern and South Central Divisions** accounting for 56% of the overall total. Most armed robberies occurred at business establishments, at the street level, and at residences. Firearms continue to be the weapon of choice for the commission of armed robberies. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 63%, compared to female victims at 37%.

Robberies increased by 4% with 96 incidents, compared to 92 in 2020. Robberies occurred mostly between the hours 6pm and 8pm. Based on preliminary figures, robberies were more likely to occur on a Tuesday than any other day of the week. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 62%, compared to female victims at 38%.

Stolen vehicles increased by 29% with 296 incidents, compared to 230 in 2020. **Nissans** were the most targeted vehicles representing 40% of all vehicles stolen. Nissan Note and Nissan March were the predominant models stolen, while residences were the most targeted locations. Stolen vehicle cases were more prevalent in the Southwestern Division which accounted for 23% of the overall total. Thirty-four percent of stolen vehicles for 2021 were recovered.

Stealing from vehicles decreased by 21% with 690 incidents, compared to 869 in 2020. The most frequent items stolen included cash, car batteries, personal effects and cellular phones. Nissan Notes were most frequently targeted, with Honda Accords trending close behind. Based on preliminary figures, stealing from vehicles were more likely to occur on a Friday than any

other day of the week. Stealing from vehicle cases were mostly reported in the Southwestern, Northeastern and Cable Beach Divisions accounting for 37% of reported cases.

Housebreakings decreased by 14% with 522 incidents, compared to 606 in 2020. The **New Providence District** accounted for 338 or 65% of all housebreakings, most of which occurred in the **Eastern**, Southwestern, South Central and Southeastern Divisions accounting for 54% of all cases. **Grand Bahama**, including **Abaco and Bimini**, accounted for 106 or 20% of housebreakings, most of which occurred in Abaco with 49 incidents. The **Family Islands District** accounted for the remaining 78 or 15% of housebreakings, most of which occurred in Eleuthera with 28 incidents.

Shopbreakings decreased by 9% with 495 incidents, compared to 546 in 2020. The **New Providence District** accounted for 388 or 78% of all shopbreakings, most of which occurred in the **Northeastern Division**, accounting for 25% of all cases. **Grand Bahama**, including **Abaco and Bimini**, accounted for 53 or 11% of shopbreakings, most of which occurred in the **Central Division** with 16 incidents. The **Family Islands District** accounted for the remaining 54 or 11% of shopbreakings, most of which occurred in Andros with 21 incidents. Based on preliminary figures, shopbreakings were more likely to occur on a Friday than any other day of the week.

For the period in review, a total of 277 **firearms** and 3,430 rounds of ammunition were discovered and/or seized throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result, 145 persons were charged with possession of illegal firearms. Additionally, **ShotSpotter** detected a total of 704 gunshot incidents, consisting of 470 multiple shots , 162 single shots and 72 probable shot incidents, totaling 2,933 rounds discharged.


There were 1,218 curfew breaches and an additional 2,518 breaches to the Emergency Powers Order. Furthermore, officers of the Royal Bahamas Police Force conducted 26,625 field check patrols, 852 road checks and executed 714 search warrants throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result of these efforts, 17,008 persons were arrested for various major and minor offences. Of this number, 7,157 persons were charged and placed before the Court, representing a 42% charge rate.







In 2021, murders increased by 63%, with 119 cases compared to 73 in 2020.











Murder Solvency Rate




Sexual Offences


For the period in review, armed robberies increased by 33%, with 415 incidents, compared to 313 in 2020.















In 2021, housebreakings decreased by 14%, with 522 incidents compared to 606 in 2020.





Stolen Vehicles




