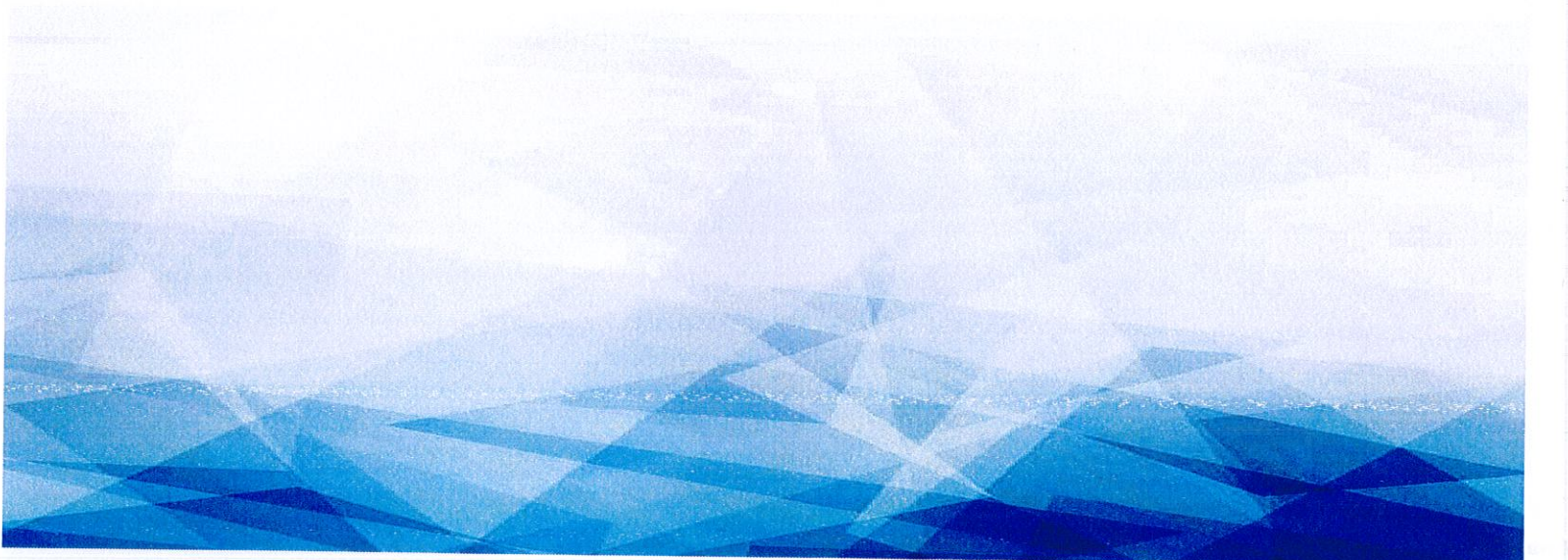

ONE HUNDRED AND FOUR (104) PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FOR COCAINE

- (41) for Possession of Cocaine,
- (63) for Possession W/I to Supply Cocaine,

ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND SIXTY (1460) PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FOR MARIJUANA

- (838) for Possession of Marijuana,
- (605) for Possession W/I to Supply Marijuana,
- (17) for Marijuana Plants.

Eighty-two (82) persons arrested for possession of Cocaine and Marijuana

Forty-five (45) PERSONS WERE ARRESTED AND QUESTIONED REFERENCE TO DANGEROUS DRUGS (NOT CHARGED).

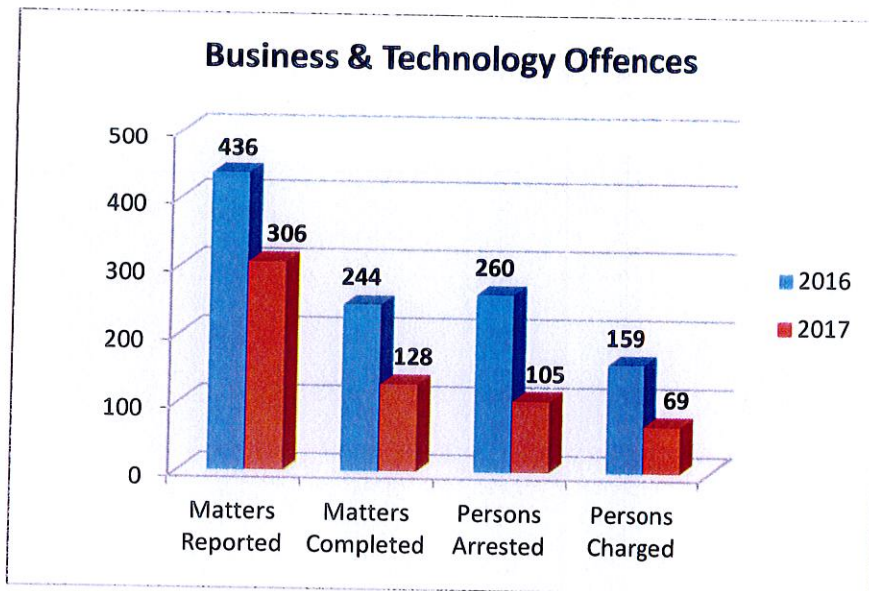
