Nationwide Crime Analysis 4th Quarter 2021 vs 2020

Preliminary figures for the 4th Quarter 2021 indicate that major crimes increased by 3% with 1054 cases, compared to 1027 over the same period in 2020. There was a 19% regional decrease in crime on the Family Islands when compared to the same period in 2020. However, there were regional increases in New Providence and Grand Bahama at rates of 3% and 14% respectively, when compared to 2020.

Crimes against the person remain unchanged with 208 cases, compared to 209 over the same period in 2020. There was a 4% regional decrease in New Providence and a 54% increase in Grand Bahama. The Family Islands District crimes against person remained unchanged. Crimes against the property increased by 3% with 846 cases, compared to 818 over the same period in 2020. There was a 21% regional decrease on the Family Islands. However, there were regional increases in New Providence and Grand Bahama at rates of 5% and 10% respectively.

Homicides increased by 74% with 33 incidents, compared to 19 over the same period in 2020. There were 26 murders in New Providence, 6 in Grand Bahamas, and 1 in the Family Islands District, with an overall solvency rate of 67%. Victims between the ages of 18 and 35 represented 61% of all homicides. Based on preliminary figures, homicides were more likely to occur on a Tuesday than any other day of the week. Homicides were more prevalent in the **Southern and Central Divisions**, accounting for 36% of the overall total. Fatal gunshot wounds was the leading cause of death for homicides accounting for 85% or 28 incidents.

Armed Robberies increased by 2% with 97 incidents, compared to 95 over the same period in 2020. Armed Robberies occurred mostly between the hours of 6pm and 11pm. Based on preliminary figures, armed robberies were more likely to occur on a Monday and Friday than any other days of the week. Armed Robberies were more prevalent in the **Southwestern and Northeastern Divisions**, accounting for 36% of the overall total. Most armed robberies occurred at business establishments, at the street level and at residences. Firearms continue to be the weapon of choice for the commission of armed robberies. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 60%, compared to female victims at 40%.

Robberies decreased by 14% with 24 incidents compared to 28 over the same period in 2020. Robberies occurred mostly between the hours 10am and 4pm. Based on preliminary figures, robberies were more likely to occur on a Friday than any other day of the week. Males represented the highest percentage of victims at 63%, compared to female victims at 37%.

Stolen vehicles increased by 39% with 89 incidents, compared to 64 over the same period in 2020. **Nissans** were the most targeted vehicles, representing 39% of all vehicles stolen. The Nissan March was the predominant model stolen, while residence were the most targeted locations. Stolen vehicle cases were more prevalent in the **Southwestern and Central Divisions**, accounting for 27% of the overall total. Thirty percent of stolen vehicles were recovered for the 4th quarter of 2021.

Stealing from vehicles increased by 43% with 200 incidents, compared to 140 over the same period in 2020. The most frequent items stolen included electronics, cash, catalytic converters and personal effects. Nissan Notes were mostly frequently targeted, with Honda Accords trending close behind. Based on preliminary figures, stealing from vehicles were more likely to occur on Friday than any other day of the week. Stealing from Vehicle cases were mostly reported in the **Northeastern, Southwestern, Central and Southeastern Divisions**, accounting for 47% of reported cases.

Housebreakings decreased by 39% with 112 incidents, compared to 184 over the same period in 2020. The New Providence District accounted for 78 or 70% of all housebreakings, most of which occurred in the South-Central and Southwestern Division, accounting for 31% of cases. Grand Bahama, including Abaco and Bimini, accounted for 21 or 19% of all housebreakings, most of which occurred in Southwestern and Abaco Divisions with 12 incidents. The Family Islands District accounted for the remaining 13 or 11% of housebreakings, most of which occurred in Eleuthera with 6 incidents. Based on preliminary figures, housebreakings were more likely to occur on a Tuesday than any other day of the week.

Shopbreakings increased by 4% with 154 incidents compared to 148 over the same period in 2020. The **New Providence District** accounted for 119 or 77% of all shopbreakings, most of which occurred in the **Northeastern, South-Central and Central Divisions,** accounting for 63% of all cases. **Grand Bahama,** including **Abaco and Bimini,** accounted for 24 or 16% of shopbreakings, most of which occurred in the **Central and Southwestern Divisions**, with 15 incidents. The **Family Islands District** accounted for the remaining 11 or 7% of shopbreakings, most of which occurred in **Eleuthera** with 6 incidents. Based on preliminary figures, shopbreakings were more likely to occur on a Friday than any other day of the week.

For the period in review, a total of 63 **firearms** and 632 rounds of ammunition were discovered and seized throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result, 66 persons were charged with possession of illegal firearms. Additionally, **ShotSpotter** detected 230 gunshot incidents, consisting of 160 multiple shots, 52 single shot incidents and 18 probable shots, totaling 837 rounds discharged.

There were 34 curfew breaches and an additional 71 breaches to the Emergency Powers Order. Furthermore, officers of the Royal Bahamas Police Force conducted 5,155 field check patrols, 187 road checks and executed 4 warrants of arrest throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. As a result of these efforts, 3,152 persons were arrested for various major and minor offences. Of this number, 1444 suspects were charged and placed before the court, representing a 46% charge rate.





For the 4th quarter of 2021, murders increased by 74% with 33 cases compared to 19 over the same period in 2020.












Murder Solvency Rate 4th Quarter



Sexual Offences









Armed Robbery

For the 4th quarter of 2021, armed robberies increased by 2% with 97 incidents, compared to 95 in 2020.




















Housebreaking

For the 4th quarter of 2021, housebreakings decreased by 39% with 112 incidents, compared to 184 over the same period in 2020.













Stealing from Vehicle

For the 4th quarter of 2021, stealing from a vehicle increased by 43% with 200 incidents, compared to 140 over the same period in 2020. Items of choice stolen from vehicles mostly consisted of electronics, auto parts, cash and documents. Residences were the most targeted areas for this crime representing 40% of stealing incidents. Stealing from vehicles mostly occurred with the **Northeastern** and **Southwestern Divisions**.















For the 4th quarter of 2021, stolen vehicles increased by 39% with 89 incidents, compared to 64 over the same period in 2020. Twenty seven (27) or 30% of vehicles stolen for the month were recovered.






Detection Rates - All Bahamas 4th Quarter






Cybercrime

Persons Arrested

For period in review, the police arrested 3,152 persons for various major and minor offences throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. **New Providence** accounted for 2,259 or 72% of all persons arrested, **Grand Bahama & the Northern Bahamas** accounted for 610 or 19%, and the **Family Islands District** accounted for 283 or 9%. Males accounted for 2,739 or 87% of arrests, and females accounted for the remaining 413 or 13% of arrests.









Persons Charged


For the period in review, the police charged 1,444 persons for various major and minor offences throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas. **New Providence** accounted for 947 or 65% of all persons charged, **Grand Bahama and the Northern Bahamas** accounted for 299 or 21%, and the **Family Islands District** accounted for 198 or 14%. Males accounted for 1,161 or 80% of persons charged, and females accounted for the remaining 283 or 20% of persons charged.


Charged - District



The period in review, there were 3,152 persons arrested, of which 46% or 1,444 suspects were charged before the Court.













Productivity Loss

For the period in review, the Organization accounted for 12,079 sick days at an estimated loss of \$1.5m. Police Officers on industrial leave accounted for 2,046 or 17% of the overall sick days. The contracted ranks accounted for \$1.3m or 87% of all productivity losses due to sick reports. The New Providence District accounted for \$1.2M or 80% of the overall productivity losses with Grand Bahama District and the Family Islands District accounting for 12% and 8% respectively.









For the period in review, 154 officers were on 4hour sedentary duties accounting for an estimated loss of \$49K.
